As a partner of the National Parks Service, we are proud to offer a Santa Cruz Valley National Heritage Area Passport Cancellation Stamp in the nationwide Passport to Your National Parks® program. This means your site can be a participating location where stamp collectors get their NPS Passport Books stamped.

To be eligible, Sites must meet the following:

- Operates within the Santa Cruz Valley National Heritage Area boundaries
- Open to the public on a regular and consistent basis
- Mission aligns with SCVNHA, and public engagement/interpretation connects with two or more of the following SCVNHA storylines:

Sonoran Desert  
Sky Islands & Desert Seas  
Streams in the Desert  
Bird Habitats

Native American Lifeways  
Desert Farming  
Ranching Traditions  
Spanish & Mexican Frontier

Mining Booms  
U.S.-Mexico Border Culture  
U.S. Military Posts on the  
Mexico Border

Please also be advised that SCVNHA Passport Stamp Sites must:

- Pay \$56 stamp production fee OR arrange to train your staff as Concierge Ambassadors. This involves a 1-hour educational session at your site for a minimum of 2 people (staff, volunteers, docents).
- Have the SCVNHA stamp on-display and available to the public during operating hours.
- Request replacement SCVNHA stamps when needed.
- Notify SCVNHA staff if your location wishes to discontinue serving as a stamp site.
